

Curriculum Overview for Music Term 6

Year 8	<p>Project title: Samba</p> <p>Students are learning about the origins and main features of Samba music. They have done a whole class performance of a Samba piece and are now working in smaller groups to compose and perform their own piece at the end of the project.</p> <p>Key skills/concepts</p> <p>Samba rhythms Structure Composition Performance Group work</p> <p>Yr 8 students will not have an ILP for music in term 6.</p>
Year 9	<p>Project title: Indian Fusion</p> <p>Students have been learning about the main features of Indian music, and are currently working in groups on their own compositions which will be a fusion between Indian music and a style of their choice.</p> <p>Key skills/concepts</p> <p>Indian elements- rag, drone and tal Structure Composition Performance Group work</p> <p>ILP: students have been asked to write a magazine review on 3 types of music from around the world.</p>
Year 10	<p>Music BTEC</p> <p>Project title: Working as a musical ensemble</p> <p>Students have been looking at various different types of musical ensembles and the roles within them. They have been asked to do a presentation to the class on 29 June describing a range of ensembles and this will form part of their assessment. They have now started to form their own ensembles and will be working on a performance of a song of their choice to perform in the Summer Music Concert on 22 July. Their performance in the concert will also be assessed.</p> <p>Key skills/concepts</p> <p>Types of ensembles Roles within them Management Performance Group work</p> <p>Homework: Students are currently working on their presentations about musical ensembles.</p>
