Write in formal standard English. I can do this by: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• avoiding slang, colloquialisms and use of the first person• using complex vocabulary and a range of sentence structures.	
Use a range of writers' devices to influence the reader. I can do this by: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• using rhetorical devices such as rhetorical questions, groups of three, exaggeration, contrast, repetition, simile and metaphor, emotive vocabulary.	

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
