There is much to celebrate even in the short time that the school has been in its wonderful new building.

- The 14 -19 curriculum offer has been planned and Year 9 students will shortly be taking their options
- The new pastoral structure and vertical tutor groups are now embedded and producing excellent results – students are very positive about the impact it is having
- Progress of students is greater than ever before
- Key performance indicators are all up and positive. Fixed term exclusions have been reduced by 80% and at 95%, attendance at the school is at its highest point to date and above borough and national averages
