### **Agenda item 1- General welcome and introduction- KWE**

<b>Points</b>	<b>Action</b>
KWE welcomed students to meeting and thanked them for their commitment in being a part of the School Council	

### **Agenda item 2 – ILP review JSU**

<b>Points</b>	<b>Action</b>
JSU posed two questions to student councillors <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In principle, are ILPs right for The Elmgreen School?</li> <li>2. How can the system be improved?</li> </ol>	Some councillors believed that the ILP model was not right for TES. Most Councillors agreed that an extended project was the right model for TES because it allowed students freedom of how and when to do a task; encourages independence and prepares students for controlled assessment tasks. Improvements which were suggested were that all ILPs should be broken down into shorter weekly tasks and should be handed in or checked on a weekly basis.

Student council members complained of the ill fitting school trousers for girls and requested to have them changed so that they can wear the same colours as the boys.  Uniform: Year 11 to be able to wear different jumpers to the rest of the school	Students reminded to refer to planner in regards to school uniform KWE will ask DHOCs to remind students in assembly about wearing the correct/appropriate footwear KWE to pass information on to ST and feedback to School Council
